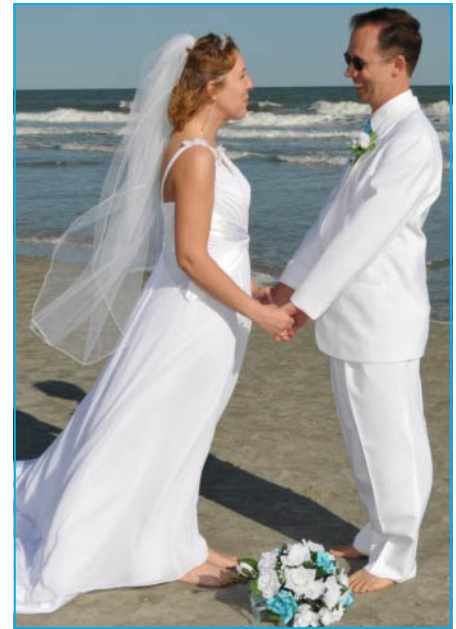


**Scott & Jolene Rosene,

- ♥ **Burundi YFC:** Thieves broke into the Youth for Christ office in this African nation and stole computers, cameras, a scanner, and all kinds of machines. The biggest issue is five passports from volunteers, some of whom are unable to return home without them. This is further complicated by the fact there are no embassies in Burundi.
- ♥ **Health:** I've been having far fewer, and much less intense headaches lately, so thank you for praying – I can feel the difference! Please continue to pray as they aren't completely gone. I'm also enjoying a respite from my chronic stomach problems and praying they don't return or require additional medication.
- ♥ **Finances:** We feel very blessed to have been able to pay off our wedding and honeymoon expenses with help from our generous family and friends. My mission support account is still about \$1,000 short per month, creating some strain on our budget, and Jolene's work hours at the Cancer Clinic have been cut to save her job, so we're cutting back and praying for God's continued provision.
